Face Covering Bylaw

Face Coverings are required.

On Thursday July 23, 2020, the Niagara Regional Council passed a temporary face covering by-law (By-law 2020-46) to require residents to wear mandatory face coverings in enclosed public places, and on Regional and municipal transit during the COVID-19 pandemic.

This by-law is to help reduce the spread of COVID-19 in indoor public spaces as more businesses and services begin to reopen.



Physical Distancing Tips

Elevator Etiquette:

- Avoid overcrowding take the stairs or wait for the next elevator
- Cover your cough, Avoid touching your face after pushing the button
- Limit the number in an elevator car to 1 Person or 1 household
- Wash with soap or sanitize your hands after leaving the elevator
